

WHAT IS HARM REDUCTION?

Harm reduction is the act of reducing harm associated with drug use through a variety of different interventions. The main goal of harm reduction is to save lives while protecting the health and well-being of people who use drugs (PWUD) and their communities.








A FEW KEY PRINCIPLES


Harm reduction uses a nonjudgmental approach that doesn't view drug use as a moral failure.





Parm reduction is grounded in social justice, and recognizes that substance use and addiction affect marginalized communities disproportionately.

Harm reduction isn't limited to direct service community work!



WHY DOES HARM REDUCTION GET SUCH A BAD REP?



Argument:

You're just enabling substance use and making excuses!

Argument:

People who use drugs are bad, and deserve to be punished!



Counter:

Harm reduction acknowledges that substance use will happen regardless of whether resources are available.

Counter:


Harm reduction recognizes that using drugs is not a moral failing.

WHY DOES HARM REDUCTION GET SUCH A BAD REP?



Argument:


I want people to get help, but can't they get it somewhere else? It's going to make crime rates skyrocket! (NIMBY)





Counter:

There is no empirical evidence that suggests this is a definitive outcome.
